Rainbow's mission is to create a community that connects children with the support they need to navigate grief and heal from loss. Rainbows for All Children trains adult

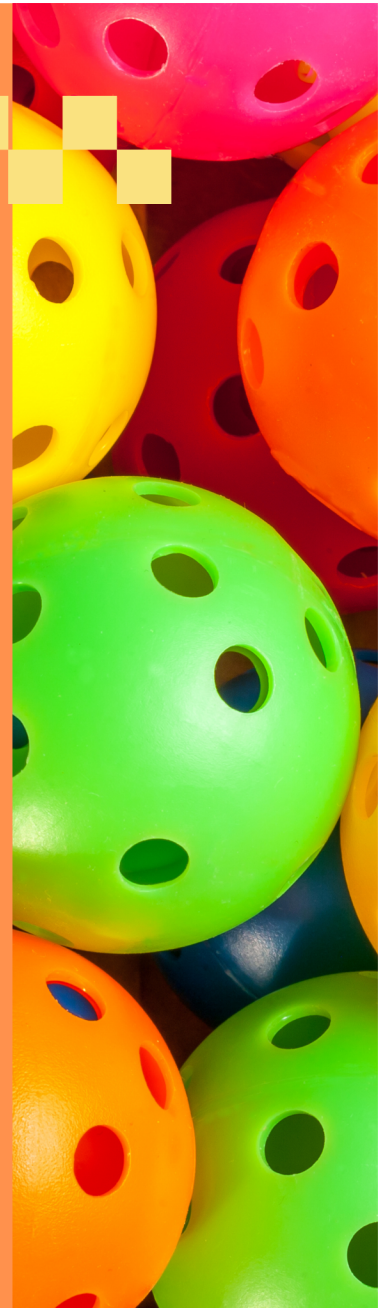

Programs are available for youth ages 3-25 with tailored curriculum for each age group.
